DISCUSSION ITEMS:

- New Items:
 - Joanna is our new STS and she gave us an update on technology:
 - The District provided \$65,978 in funds for new technology. This is how the funds were allocated for CCE:
 - 12 desktop computers for staff, 122 cloudbooks (laptops) for student use, and 90 ipads for student use
 - CCE elected to use some of the school money and the Trust Lands money to upgrade to touch screen cloudbooks (which is what we currently use) and purchase more ipads. The total for these upgrades were \$31,298. \$25,000 of that money came from the current Trust Lands fund.
 - We are also getting 7 new carts. 2 were paid for by a grant and 5 were paid for by the school
 - With these new additions grades 3-6 will be at a 1:1 ratio. We need 3 more carts for grades K-2 to be at this ratio.
 - The Superintendent would like all the schools to be operating at a 1:1 ratio which is why the money is being spent on technology. This does not mean kids are on devices more, just that they are more devices so teachers can better control their schedules and don't have to compete with other teachers for technology use.
 - School Improvement Plan: Proposed Funds Allocation: \$102,296
 - Increase Acadience reading scores by 3%: \$80,796
 - 2 Reading Tutors
 - Firebird Reading Tutor
 - Equipment-Laptops & Ipads: \$35,796
 - Increase Rise & CRT math scores by 3%: \$15,500
 - Math Tutors
 - Professional Development: \$5,000
 - Substitutes
 - Supplies

- Physical and Digital Safety: \$500
- Provide activities, lessons, and materials for Social Emotional Learning: \$500
